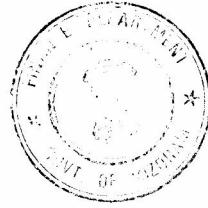

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Aizawl, the 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2011

Subject: Family Pension – Extension of the scope of Family Pension to the dependant disabled siblings (i.e brother/sisters) of Government servants/pensioners.

In continuation to this Department's Office Memorandum No.G.19011/23/2003-F.APF/PT dt. 7.9.2010 and in line with the Office Memorandum No.1/15/2008-P & PW (E) dt. 17.8.2009 issued by Government of India, Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare, New Delhi, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to include the dependant disabled (i.e brothers/sisters) of Government Servants/Pensioners in the definition of family for the purpose of eligibility for family pension. Therefore, such disabled siblings shall be eligible for family pension for life in the same manner and following the same disability criteria as laid down in Rule 54 of the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 in the case of son/daughter of Government employees/pensioners suffering from any disorder or disability of mind (including mentally retarded) or physically crippled or disabled, so as to render him/her unable to earn a living even after attaining the age of 25 yrs.

The CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 shall therefore stand modified to that extent.

The employees and pensioners under the Govt. of Mizoram should submit a fresh declaration of family members quoting their brothers and sisters who are disabled as per the criteria laid down in Rule 54 of the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972.
